Below are the items from the Traveler that seemed good for possible summer work. The whole list is on page 462 in your book. Get printouts or write about the items you do and bring them to a special den or pack meeting during the summer or when we start again in the fall.

Do 5 items

- 3. With an adult, use a map website to plan a trip from your house to a nearby place of interest. Print out the directions and a map for the destination.
- 4. With an adult, take a trip to a nearby place of interest. Write about where you went and how you got there and back.
- 5. Figure out what it costs per mile for one of the trips you planned or took for one of these other items. Don't forget the costs of getting back.
- 6. Decide on four trips of at least 25 miles round trip you might like to take. Draw each on a highway map. Take and act as navigator for at least one of these trips. Tell me about the trip.
- 7. Decide on a trip you would like to take that lasts at least two day. Pack everything you will need for the trip. Tell me about the (real or imagined) trip and what you needed.
- 8. Check the first aid kit(s) in the family car(s) to see if it has what is needed. Tell me about what you found.
- 9. Get a road map (or atlas). Look at the legend to learn the symbols. Bring the map and show the den what you learned.
- 10. Using a road map of you area, plan two different routes to a nearby place of interest. Measure them in miles using the legend and find out which route is shorter.
- 11. Make a list of safety precautions you as the traveler need to take when travelling by: car, bus, plane, boat and train. (see page 472)
