

Autumn Leaf Woggle

You Need:

- 1 wooden leaf – I found several styles of precut leaf shapes a couple inches across at Michael's.
- Pre-drill the four holes as shown in the pictures large enough for the leather lace you have.
- 1 cardboard piece
- 1 piece of double stick tape
- Variety of Fall colors of craft paint
- 1 leather lace about 12"
- Beads

Steps:

1. Put your name on the back of the leaf.
2. Mount the leaf on the cardboard with the double stick tape to make painting easier.
3. Paint the main leaf color. Don't put the paint on too thick, just get it covered.
4. Let it dry.
5. Paint on the veins and the stem.
6. Let it dry, then take it off the cardboard.
7. Mark the middle of the lace and tie a single overhand knot there.
8. Put the lace in through one hole from the back.
9. Put the lace back through the hole to the side (left-right not up-down) of the first hole.
10. Put the other end of the lace in from the back to the front and back again, BUT GO THE OTHER DIRECTION RIGHT OR LEFT from the first time.
11. Put beads on each end of the lace and tie a single overhand knot right at the end of the lace. Work the knot down really tight to keep it from untying.

Using the woggle:

1. Pull a loop of lace out behind the leaf.
2. Put your neckerchief through the loop and bring it up to your neck.
3. Pull the two beaded ends to tighten the loop. **DON'T PULL TOO HARD!**
